Keeping MK moving... by train



A new platform at Milton Keynes Central station opened in January 2009. Other recent improvements include the launch of five services an hour to London, more 12-car trains running during peak times, and significantly improved weekend services.

There are more and more services stopping at Milton Keynes Central all the time. Along with the obvious destinations, commuters can now get a direct train to Croydon, Chester and North Wales.

Car parking is being increased at Bletchley and Wolverton Stations. A new station building is also to be provided at Wolverton and work is ongoing to improve facilities at Station Square. Future plans for MK's train service include introducing an East-West rail link.
