It was with the closure of the Oxide works, on the site of the former E & H Roberts iron foundry, that the Deanshanger Village Heritage Society was formed in 1999 to preserve and celebrate this history.

Since inauguration its achievements include winning 3 environmental care awards, writing the 'Images of a Village' book, mounting over 20 exhibitions, and most notably re-instating The Feast; a festive gathering on The Green held every October that raises money for local charities.
