A tradition since 2001, the West Bletchley Carnival on Sunday 12th June 2010 focuses on 'The Musicals'.

Its spectacular parade of bands, decorated floats and fancy dress entries is traditionally followed by displays in Rickley Park – like parachutists, motor cyclists, dog handlers and dancers.

A 'family fun day' with its 'village fete atmosphere' includes music, fairground shows like Punch and Judy, and specialist displays such as birds of prey, hunting dogs, ferret racing and wrestling.
