

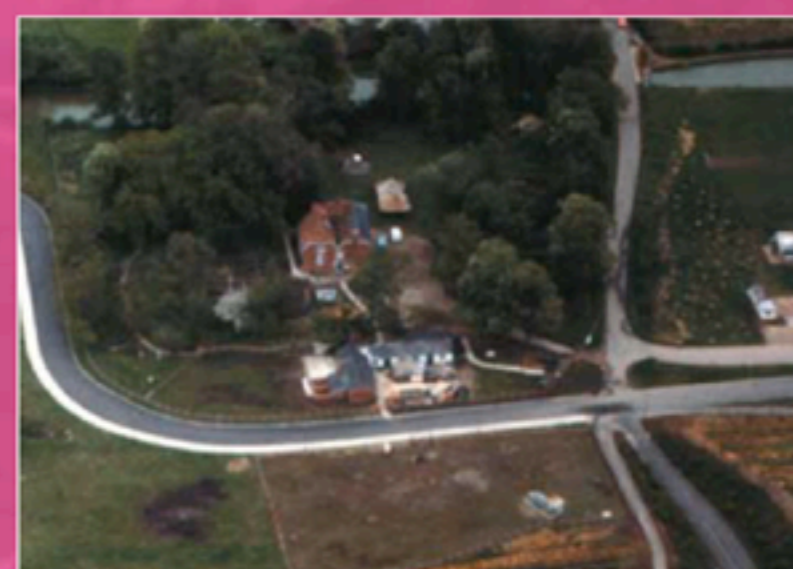
The Old Rectory



This historic listed site is an inspiring location which has been occupied since medieval times.

From early times, there was a succession of wooden structures which would be replaced by the present house in the 18th century. The Grand Union Canal took part of the moat at the beginning of the 19th century, but evidence of it remains along with an ancient pond and woodland.

Extensively refurbished in 1976 when the Inter-Action Trust arrived, the site has since been a host to many community events.



The site has evolved over the years and though plans for a major extension in the 1990s didn't progress, The Old Rectory continues to be a hub of community arts activity.
